1. What is Adobe Photoshop?

Answer:

2. What is the difference between raster and vector graphics?

Raster graphics are pixel-based and lose quality when resized, while **vector graphics** are based on mathematical paths and can be resized without losing quality.

3. What are layers in Photoshop?

Layers in Photoshop are individual levels where you can place elements (images, text, shapes, etc.). They allow you to edit each element independently, making the editing process flexible and non-destructive.

4. What is the Clone Stamp Tool used for?

The **Clone Stamp Tool** is used to copy pixels from one part of an image and paint them onto another area, often used for retouching or removing unwanted objects.

5. What is the difference between the Healing Brush and the Clone Stamp Tool?

 - The **Clone Stamp Tool** directly copies pixels from one area to another, without blending.
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6. What is a mask in Photoshop?

A **mask** in Photoshop allows you to hide or reveal parts of a layer non-destructively. It lets you create complex compositions by hiding parts of an image without permanently deleting them.

7. How do you adjust the brightness and contrast in Photoshop?

8. What is the difference between the Magic Wand and the Quick Selection Tool?

10. How do you create a new document in Photoshop?
